production per farm number, yield per farm number, and supporting documents of production (1007, warehouse receipts). The deadline has been set for Friday, January 24, 2020 in our office by 4:30 pm.

COTTON YIELD CONTEST...

- Contest is voluntary.
- Deadline for entries Friday,
 January 24, 2020 by 4:30 PM in our office.
- Growers must deliver official producer cotton bale list plus gin summary (no



- handwritten receipt will be accepted).
- Provide all FSA numbers where cotton was grown.
- Yield must include all acreage grown including out of county/state acreage.
- Must be growing 50 or more acres of cotton.
- Northampton must be the home or control county.
- Entries must be from person doing the work or directly supervising hired employees to carry out management practices necessary for the welfare of the crop.

RESPIRATOR FIT TESTING – 2020


