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REGISTRATION

- 1.To enroll in any 4-H Summer Program, Youth must be enrolled in 4HOnline.
- 2. Fill out registration form online.
- 3. Turn in payment. Paid in cash (exact change only) or check to Northampton County Program Fund.
- 4. Payment is due prior to attending each workshop. Checks or exact cash will be accepted. Please make checks payable to Northampton County 4-H Program Fund. You may drop payment off at the Northampton County Extension Office (9495 NC Hwy 305N. Jackson NC, 27845).
- 5. No refunds will be given for Summer Fun programs except in the event of a cancellation by our office. All refunds will be processed at the conclusion of the entire summer fun program in August. Please allow 4 weeks from that time for checks to be processed.
